

A Barn Venue Bringing Things Full Circle

"The barn itself is a magical space, it's breathtaking, and it's so unique," says Jessica Knouse, wedding and events coordinator at Round Barn Weddings and Events. "We're a fourth-generation family business with close ties to the community. We're dedicated and invested in making each couple's special day more than perfect."

You must see the Historic Round Barn full circle to capture its distinctive beauty, as it is one of only a handful of true round barns still surviving today. Built in 1914, the rustic, yet elegant structure is nestled among rolling hillsides and apple orchards in the heart of Adams County wine country.

Its unique, circular floor plan accommodates a variety of intimate seating arrangements for up to 225 guests, space for a live band, and a large dance area. With 60-foot-high ceilings and a custom-made Edison bulb chandelier, couples can create a space as casual or as elegant as they can imagine. An outdoor wedding ceremony option on the hillside overlooking the barn and orchard promises memories for years to come and photos that will take your breath away.

"We want people to feel connected to the space as much as we feel connected to this beautiful piece of land in Adams County," says Knouse. "The care we put into preserving our venue and our orchard is the same care we offer to our couples."
